Purpose

Piet Oudolf is a garden designer known for his planting designs for the New York High Line and landscape designs around the world. He has gained worldwide acclaim for his innovative ideas that find beauty in the cycle of life, even in withering forms, by creating exquisite gardens that focus on perennials and plants that are native to the land.

In the transition from a consumer society to a sustainable society, there is growing interest in the importance of urban green spaces and the well-being of city dwellers. Approach spaces that allow people to experience the seasonal scenery with all their senses, notice small changes, and naturally make people want to walk through them, foster communication with others and lead to a richer way of spending time. The use of urban exterior spaces offers suggestions of this richness, freeing people from shelter and reconnecting them with nature.

Drawing from interviews in his own garden in the Netherlands, we introduce Oudolf's gardens, which offer enchanting views from season to season.
